

Thoughts and Voices

We are all aware of laws and rules in this “natural realm”, the physical, the Universe. Whether children, teens or adults, we grow up learning that there are consequences to breaking them. Knowing what to do (and not do) and not aligning yourself to it, is disobedience. Which will become rebellion.

This disobedience comes from not knowing or accepting what God says.

Your Beliefs. Which are mostly built on what God didn't say.

You are born empty of beliefs and attitudes.

They come from many sources, including experience, environment, trusted people and systems, media, books, screen entertainment, conversations etc etc.

But the **gateway they all come to is your thought realm.**

2 Cor 10:5 “Take every thought captive to the obedience of Christ”.

Filter all thoughts thru God's Word. If they don't agree, don't accept it, irrespect how popular.

What you dwell on and accept, you will base decisions on, you will speak out and you will act upon.

God's Word, as a base, is Supernatural.

There are do's and dont's, basically guidelines to life, at a Supernatural or “Spiritual” level, that have Supernatural consequences.

There is God (the Father) in Heaven, the supernatural and us on Earth in this Universe, the natural realm.

We **choose** to either align to and **please HIM or please ourSELF**, based on our accumulated beliefs (right or wrong), or personal whims at the time.

He created us in His image, not just arms and legs, but with a Soul, like Him, (and nothing and no-one else has a soul other than Mankind) which apart from emotions and reason, allows us to **CHOOSE**.

We should live for the positive consequences.

They are of a spiritual (Supernatural) nature (above natural law).

We don't want to reap the consequences of breaking them.

Especially, because we have very little idea what that means.

I don't want to digress here because I don't want you to lose the thread and aim of this doc.

But you need to know, so you understand how important this is to you and who know you.

We are not alone here.

The Earth and Universe (the natural or Physical realm) were created to house the fallen angels.

A home away from Home.

God put Man here too.

The angels were huge super-strong knowledgeable godlike (to mere humans) and were treated as such.

The gods of “mythology”....but in Heaven terms, they *were* His servants.

Lucifer is their leader, who was the Archangel of Worship, and who stole Adam's God given authority over this World.

The Bible talks of them finding women “fair” and that there were giants in the land at that time.

We have to read between the lines.

Just as Jesus (pre-birth) and Angels have been seen and walked and ate with us (tho they are Spirit), were able to move thru the veil from the Supernatural, manifesting in the Natural.

Those sent here had lived with God for aeons and had great knowledge.

They toyed with creating their own beings here.

God brought massive changes when He flooded the Earth.

Apart from changing the structure and alignment of the Earth, He put the Angels (spirits) in a holding pen in “Hell”, and disembodied the beings they created, leaving the ungodly spirits (demons).

Lucifer, because of his authority (God given to Adam) is still free, until the Lord's return.

Why all that?

Each of the demon types have characteristics.

Like fear, uncleanness, deaf and dumb, rebellion, revenge, hatred, manipulation and control,.....

Yes, every ungodly characteristic.

My Bible still says in Genesis 1:31 **“He saw everything was good”.**

Everything Bad and evil is not from Him.

They are against Him and they don't want God (our Father) to have a relationship with us. They want us to agree with them, partner with them, and live a life off track in that area of belief. Ok then.....

Basically, each of them work together to hold part of your persona hostage to their character trait. Initially, they can only throw thoughts at us.

They have no rights to us, until we accept what they say is truth (or something you prefer to "like")

Until you agree with them. A gotcha moment, for life, or until Jesus sets you free.

What is a truth? **All the facts** that support a statement, a belief, that has no lie falseness or deception in them. God's Word is truth.

The more Word you know, the more godlike you will become, the more you can discern a lie.

It is obvious where and how the thought provoking conversations come from in our living environment.

Basically like advertising or propaganda would do. Don't be passive, be alert.

What about our quiet time?

We are just sitting there, even watching or listening to something, and **a thought comes out of the blue**, with nothing to do with what our senses are taking in.

Well.

To put it simply. Three sources.

Ever watched the cartoons with the white angel on one shoulder and the black angel on the other.

Your ears in between.

Both sides of the supernatural want your attention and your acceptance and agreement. To believe.

God also needs your permission. Prayer. Everything we have in Heaven needs to be asked for.

Our defeated enemy only needs you to agree.

The third? You.

Your brain isn't like an interactive diary or alarm.

Your brain doesn't tell you that it is 8 a.m. and you need to get up now to meet you 9 a.m. dental appt.

Your brain is NOT a random INITIATOR of thoughts.

It is a responder to external thought stimulus.

It also builds upon an external thought by a thought response and further thought reasoning to reach an outcome.

The external stimulus might be a keyword or prod that stimulates your memory to recreate a topic.

Not necessarily a good and evil topic. Just a reminder.

The first external thought that I clearly remember was:

"Do you think it is wise to hear one side of a story and run with it?"

I "knew" it was from God and answered "No" and then thought "I should read the Bible", and then thought "but where should I start reading?", and I remembered someone said "If you don't know where to start, start at John". So I found a Bible and started to read John.

A lot of me there. But started with an external prod.

In the garden, the serpent (devil) said to Eve "Did God really say....."

The first recorded test from the enemy.

"Did God really say..." "is it true that..."

She got it wrong.

And so will we, if we don't know what God says.

Proverbs 4:23 says: "Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it. "

The source of your essence, your persona, what you stand for, your integrity, your thoughts, responses, motivations, emotions, activations, desires, intentions, the core of your being, are found in your heart (Soul), what you believe,

Who you are!

Your character and substance, not your external behaviour.

Be alert.

Be vigilant.

They don't go to sleep. 24/7

This is a continuous process.

Guard your mouth. Prov4:24 Avoid all perverse talk; stay away from corrupt speech.

If God your Father wouldn't say it..... Who is really speaking?

Guard your eyes. Prov4:25 Let your eyes look straight ahead; fix your gaze directly before you.

If God your Dad wouldn't like you looking at it..... Thought provoking? Whose thoughts?

Take control of your thoughts.

Not just external, but also your own thoughts.

Don't let them run wild.

Would you be happy for your thoughts to be blue-toothed?

Don't be passive.

Pause to evaluate whether the thoughts are true and align with what Jesus would say and expect.

His nature.

Replace the lies and fear and negativity with what God says.

Jesus the Man who was also the Christ, the Son of God, was not passive in His response to Lucifer.

He responded to the enemy's thought promptings with "It is written.....".

Don't be led by your "feelings, "emotions", ignorance, "what you think", the "flesh",

Prov 3:5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding"

2 Cor 5:7 "For we walk by faith, not by sight (flesh) "

Rom 8:1 "...who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit "

Romans 8:14 "For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God."

We need to live our lives based on what God says.

Let's just pause for some more reality. Don't deceive yourself.

God holds people accountable for what they think and desire (1 Samuel 16:7), not just what they do.

Sinful desire acts as a "conception" phase that leads to the "birth" of a sinful action (**James 1:15**).

Matt 15:19 For out of the heart come evil thoughts—murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander.

1John 3:15 "Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer..."

Matt 5:27 "But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lust (lustful thoughts) for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart"

Harboring sinful desires or intentional, willful lust is equivalent to **committing the sin in the heart.**

Back to 2 Cor 10:5

We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

We are talking about false, proud, argumentative teachings.

Lofty opinions

Secular humanism

Vain imaginations

Fear, anxiety, negativity

Would God our Father speak that way to you? If not, it wasn't from Him.

We need to Filter, Evaluate, Discard and Replace (if necessary)

We may need to shelve it if we don't have all the answers.

We have ultimate responsibility and authority for OUR lives and what we let in.

But it is not our responsibility to war against Spirits.

"The battle is mine says the Lord".

But we need to deal with their attacks.

We have the name of Jesus (of Nazareth) and therefore **"we have authority to tread upon scorpions and serpents and over ALL the power of the enemy"**

We are not defenceless.

We have the Word of God which is the "sword of the spirit".

Eph 6:17

2 Cor 10:4 “For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds,”

This means that spiritual battles are fought with divine power—not physical force, human strategy, or fleshly methods.

These weapons are used to dismantle mental, emotional, or spiritual barriers and align thoughts with obedience to Christ.

Rom 12:2

2 Tim 2:15

Phil 2:9-11 “Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name, that at the NAME of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.”

John 14:13 “I will do ANYTHING you ask [the Father] in my name so that the Father will be given glory because of the Son.”

Jesus has trusted us with His name, His signature to use for us and the Kingdom to the Father’s Glory.
